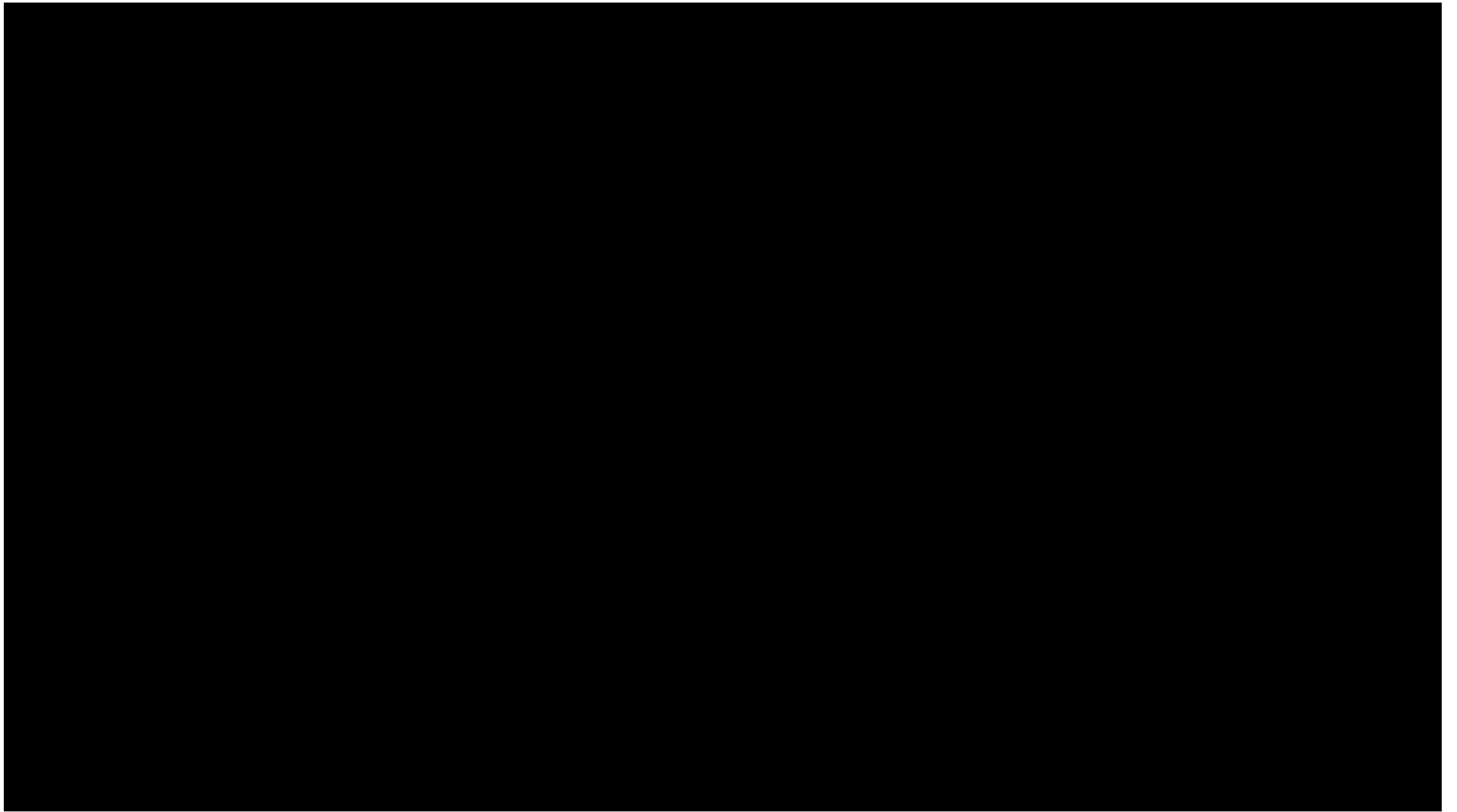
KNOWLEDGE AROUND NGĀ TAONGA TAKARO PRIOR TO WANANGA



KNOWLEDGE AROUND NGĀ TAONGA TAKARO AFTER WANANGA

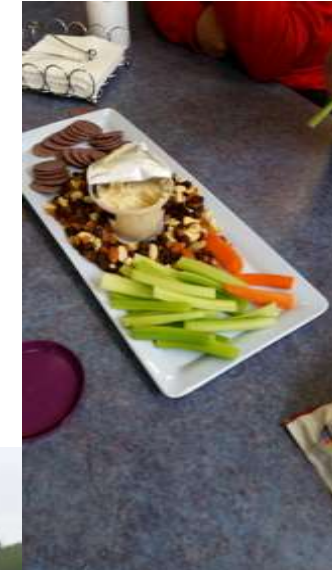

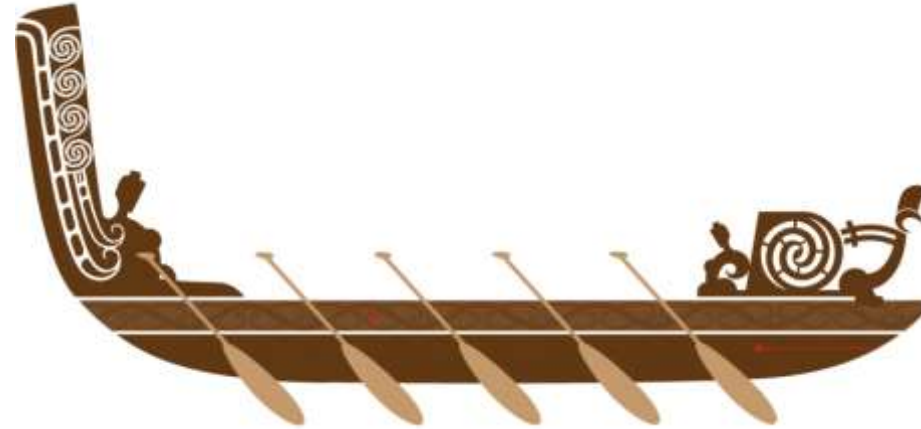
