- A smartphone app and website that navigates the user to breastfeeding friendly venues throughout Southland and Otago via icons on Google maps
- 200 venues uploaded
- One requirement to be a BURP venue = all staff must support breastfeeding on their premise




# Evaluation of the Mother and Baby Friendly Facilities Brochure



Handful of venues who declined to be part of BURP


Important to leave them with the message:

"Mosotho woman weaving a basket"




